

CHATEAU HAUT-BONNEAU

(Montagne St. Emilion)



In 1998, at the tender age of 19, Bruno Marchand found himself running his family's estate. Helped by his younger brother Olivier, he took only a few years to turn it around. Where once the wine had been sold in bulk, now it is recognized as a reference point for Montagne Saint Emilion. Planted to 80% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc, the vineyards have very distinct soil types: limestone, clay and sand. Each lends character to the wine, which is frank and flavorful, with spicy, rich, dark fruit.

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
