**“LES BONNES BOUCHES”**  
*(SANCERRE)*



**Real** Sauvignon Blanc, the best in the world, comes from Sancerre and its outlying villages in the northern center of France. Decades ago it was known mostly as a “simple” Parisian bistro wine. True, very good white wine is made from this grape all over the world, but this is from the genuine epicenter. Here there is pleasure in the clear precision of Bourgeois’ interpretation of Sauvignon: very dry suggestions of flinty soil and grapefruit zest, framed handsomely by perfectly balanced acidity. Try this beauty with seafood, goat cheese, stir-fried vegetables, as an aperitif...

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
