Appropriate, since these latitudes are home to some of the world's finest seafood cookery, with which a light, pure white is very welcome. Picpoul, the grape variety, grown near the famous old fishing port of Sète, yields body and crispness as well as deliciously focused flavors of melon, lemon, and smoke.

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
