*(Côtes de Castillon)*



Not only is the Chateau Robin Cote de Castillon one handsome wine to behold, it's a stand-up, no-nonsense, old-guard Bordeaux with character to spare. Concentrated dark fruits, with some mint, camphor, and bitter chocolate aromas; dryish, lean, firm, serious, a tad tight. Lovely with a leg of lamb. 60 percent merlot, 15 percent each of cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc, and 10 percent malbec... — *Stephen Meuse, The Boston Globe*
