Scansano is a small, medieval town in the south-west of Tuscany, not far from the coast. Morellino is the local name for the famous Sangiovese grape. Here, in the countryside celebrated in “Under The Tuscan Sun”, Erik Banti has crafted a wine for pleasure. While 90% of the wine is indeed Morellino, Erik has judiciously blended in a little Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Grenache. Unoaked, direct and flavorful, with an appetizing palate of violets and black cherries, it is a wine for generous draughts and simple food.

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
