HISTORY

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It was in 1984 when Thierry Parcé and one of his brothers vinified for the first time at La Rectorie. Thierry currently runs the domaine with his son Jean-Emmanuel, who joined him in 2010. The estate is composed of 30 hectares of vineyards, with vines that are more than 50 years old in average. The main grape variety is grenache, together with carignan, syrah, mourvèdre and counoise. Brown schists soils are the dominant type. From the diversity of plots, with different altitudes and orientations, La Rectorie elaborates a range of wines going from the dry Collioure (white, rosé and red) to the fortified sweet Banyuls, proposed in two different approaches: the *Rimage* style, aged in full tanks or barrels (protected from the air), and the traditional oxidative Banyuls. The vineyards grow in terraces overhanging the

Mediterranean, it is a mountain vineyard by the sea. Every work in the field is done by hand.
