VINE / AVERAGE AGE OF 60 YEARS OLD, SHORT PRUNING (EN ÉVENTAIL), TILLAGE, USE OF MANURE FOR THE PAST 30 YEARS, NO INSECTICIDES

WINE / NIGHT HARVEST, COLD SETTLING, AGEING ON LEES FOR 3 MONTHS, EARLY BOTTLING TO PRESERVE THE CO2
