



Devon-Terrassen - dry Trittenheimer Apotheke



The south facing main area in Trittenheimer Apotheke is extreme steep. Those Devonian slate terraces emerged 350 – 400 million years ago. These vineyards are home to 60 – 100 years old vines. Because of its peak position the vines can only be managed by hand. An absolute premium wine. A bouquet of fruit aromas combined with a hint of spicy, creamy notes, and impressive minerality. This wine's individual character comes from its own natural yeasts, slow and gentle fermentation, a unique terroir from which it originated. An absolute Premium wine with a lot of love and care that stands behind this bottle.

The 2021er Trittenheimer Apotheke Devon-Terrassen GG, is made from fruit picked on 60-100 years-old vines in the prime terraced part of Vogelsang and the Kaulsbohr sectors on the main hill and was fermented and aged in a mix of cask and stainless-steel tank. It has a gorgeously aromatic yet refined nose of almond, yellow flowers, mint, candied ginger, an earthy spices. The wine develops both great freshness and presence on the palate, where zesty elements are wrapped into minty herbs and minerals. The finish is still very tight but already delivers magnificent length and purity in a bone-dry style. There is also a hint of tartness in need of integration, something which will be done in a few years 'time.
