

Domaine Saladin FAN DE LUNE

Côtes du Rhône Villages



“Fan de Lune” means ‘child of the moon’ in local patois and is used to express surprise. The

wine was named after two surprises experienced by the family in the late 1970’s: the new appellation of the Côtes du Rhône Villages ‘terroirs’ in St Marcel d’ Ardèche and the birth of two girls, now the winemakers, Marie-Laurence and Elisabeth! Mostly Mourvedre, rounded out with Grenache Noir and Syrah. 40 year old vines, low yields. Organic, hand-picked. And spectacularly delicious.

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
