La Bastide des Deux Lunes is located in Puget-Ville, in the middle of the Permian depression that surrounds the " Massif des Maures" from Toulon to St Raphael and separates the crystalline Provence from the limestone Provence.

Bertrand Dubois regain in the early 2000s the family vineyards, previously addressed to a cooperative winery.

He knows, as an experienced and complete winemaker, that everything begins in the vineyard.

Therefore he takes good care of its 54 acres of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre and Rolle planted on limestone pebbles and degraded red sandstones.

Perfect drainage and good water supply in the summer are insured.

In 2012 new stage, wine cellar and farm buildings have sprung up ready for the new vintage.

Consultant oenologist for 15 years, Bertrand can finally apply to the development of its cuvées the advices he gave to his colleagues and clients.

This results in fine wines, elegant, complete and balanced.

" Fruity, gourmand, round and silky."

With a pale pink color - flesh hue - this wine reveals aromas of peach and white flowers. The mouth, delicate and chiseled, has a pleasant finish with citrus flavors.

Grenache 80%, Rolle 10%, Mourvèdre 10%.

Terroir : limestone pebbles and degraded red sandstones.
