Aglianico is sometimes called the King of the South, the most noble red wine grape in the Mezzogiorno. Its fans compare it to the Nebbiolo of Barolo. Perhaps the very best is produced on the Monte Vulture in Basilicata by Fabrizio Piccin of Grifalco, an ‘immigrant’ from Tuscany intent on making great organic wine. He makes several versions, but the Gricos is the most approachable, and happily, very affordable. It’s a grab bag of rich dark fruits offset with pleasantly rounded tannins. Delicious.

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
