

## CÉLINE & FREDERIC GUEGUEN CHABLIS

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Although his name is Breton, young Frederic Gueguen is a true Chablisien. He grew up among the Chardonnay vines, and has the native love of minerality. In 2013 he decided to branch out on his own. His estate is tiny, but the care he lavishes on each vine is unparalleled. He uses no oak, aiming for a stoniness and clarity he believes should define the best Chablis. This wine's straitened richness comes only from the grape and limited *batonnage* or lees-stirring. Crisp, dry and utterly true to terroir.

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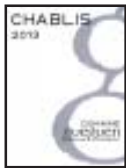
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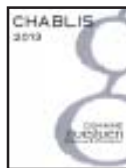
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
