

# CHÂTEAU BILLEROND

## Appellation Saint Emilion

*Château Billerond is a 16 hectares property towards the eastern part of the village of Saint Emilion and the wine is vinified without the use of oak to make a fresh, medium-bodied style.*

### Soils :

clayey with sandy parts with iron oxide in the subsoil

### Area under vine :

16.22 hectares

### Varieties :

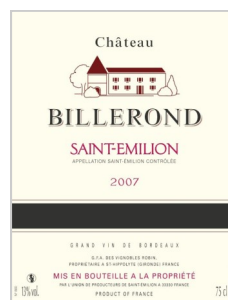
75% Merlot, 25% Cabernets

### Average age of the vines :

25 - 30 years

### Winemaking :

100% fermented in stainless steel after a pre ferment maceration of one week. Pressed vertically for a very soft extraction.



### Tasting notes:

This has lovely, soft Merlot fruit with ripe tannins and red berry fruit flavours on the palate. It sees no oak aging, thereby retaining all its fresh fruit character.

### Serving:



At room temperature. It is the perfect match for easy going food. Even better as an aperitif.
