

## VALTEA ALBARIÑO

*(Rias Baixas)*



Grown on slopes a mile from the Portuguese border, Valtea's vines are more than 30 years old. It's their concentration that allows it to balance freshness and richness. Hand-picked grapes see steel tanks and a light crush, and only the free-run juice is used. In the glass, it boasts flavors of apricot, apple and meadowsweet. As Robert Parker's Wine Advocate puts it: 'Valtea's ... Alabarino's are **first class**'.

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
