

CHÂTEAU HAUTES VERSANNES

Appellation Saint Emilion

The vineyards of Château Hautes Versannes are located in the "commune" of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens. There are 10 ha in all, on a sandy soil, planted predominantly with the Merlot (85%) and Cabernet Franc (15%).

Soils :

sandy and clayey with limestone

Area under vine / Yield :

10.60 hectares / 50 hl/ha

Varieties :

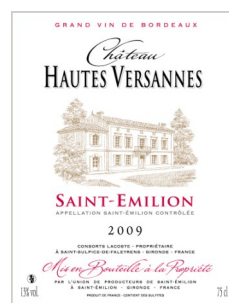
85% Merlot, 15% Cabernets

Average age of the vines :

35 years

Winemaking :

100% fermented in stainless steel after a pre ferment maceration of one week. Pressed vertically for a very soft extraction.

A soft, young wine with savoury, fresh fruit and medium length. Elegant tannins making for early drinking.
