## TASTING NOTES

This wine has a dark, near-opaque robe with bright magenta hues. The nose is intense, displaying aromas of fruit and spice.

The palate is juicy, round and lively with a pleasant acidity. The tannins are restrained but framing. Black cherries, plums and forest floor characterize the flavors. The finish is soft making it a good by-the-glass pour or an everyday sip.
