Grapes

75% Merlot
20% Cabernet Sauvignon
5% Cabernet Franc

Location : Located in the commune of Sainte Terre, south of Saint Emilion area.

Surface : 20 Ha

Soil : sandy clay

Vinification

Harvested by machine, the grapes are carefully sorted and stalked before being pressed gently to extract the juice. The alcoholic fermentation takes place in stainless steel between 30° to 32° with "pumping over". Then follows a period of maceration for 15 days to 3 weeks depending on the vintage. It ages for about 12 months in oak barrels.

Tasting

The harmonious balance of the grapes gives a great fineness. The work done in the vineyard provides a wine with deep red colour, a nose of ripe red fruit, slightly spicy with hints of vanilla and delicate wood. On the palate the attack is supple with balanced tannins, fruity and very fresh.
A balanced and harmonious wine.

Serving suggestions

This Bordeaux wine is perfect with grilled red meats and cheeses.



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
