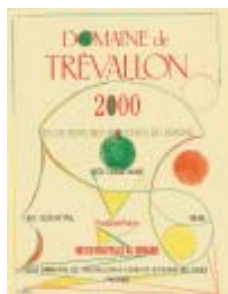


# DOMAINE DE TRÉVALLON

“Exclusion from the Baux appellation for using unauthorized grapes (half Syrah, half Cabernet Sauvignon) is only a bad memory for Eloi Durrbach, who now produces the most expensive vin de pays in the world (with the possible exception of Daumas Gassac.) In a patchwork vineyard set into the forests of Provence, full of the scents of garrigue and protected by natural predators, this magician manages to grow grapes in ecological balance. His ambition is the expression of terroir through the grape varieties best suited to transcend it. Organic cultivation and respectful vinification, aimed at the greatest expression of the grape, are all embraced to produce a thoroughbred wine, deep, very long, to drink young or very well-aged.”
